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Calendar Birthday Cakes

Directions:

1. Run off the set that's in color. Laminate them.
2. Hang them up above your white board.
3. Run off the calendar master on a variety of colored construction paper that would compliment each birthday cake.
4. Make a template of the candle flame.
5. Trace the flame on yellow construction paper and cut out a flame for as many students as you have.
6. Glue them to the candles.
7. When you know your students' birthdays write their name on a candle and the day on the flame.
8. Tape the candle to the back of the month cake that their birthday is in.
9. Run off copies of the "It's my birthday" mini-cakes to give to the children to color.
10. Or run off pre-colored ones and glue them to a strip of construction paper to make a birthday crown, or use it as a pin or necklace for the birthday child to wear.
11. Run off a copy of the colored one and laminate it. Cut it out and glue a magnet on the back to put on your white board, or use it on your calendar or birthday board.
12. Run off the black and white cakes for the birthday child to color.
13. The 1st day of the month you could tack up that month's cake. Have each student sign it. Then run copies off for as many students that have a birthday that month. They have an instant color-me card signed by all of their classmate (friends)!
14. Or since little one's handwriting seems to be huge, hang up the generic birthday sheet, have everyone sign that, run off enough student copies and then staple it to the front of the monthly birthday cake.
