Have students think of a name for their pizza that includes their name on the top line in possessive form ('s).

If you are working on counting by 10's to 100, students can make a pizza with 10 groups of 10 and use that pizza slice.

If you are working on both counting by 10's AND 5's. You might want to give students a choice.

Remind them that they will need 20 groups of 5. I have 21 different toppings to choose from for those pizzas. They will cut and color the 5's pizza slice.

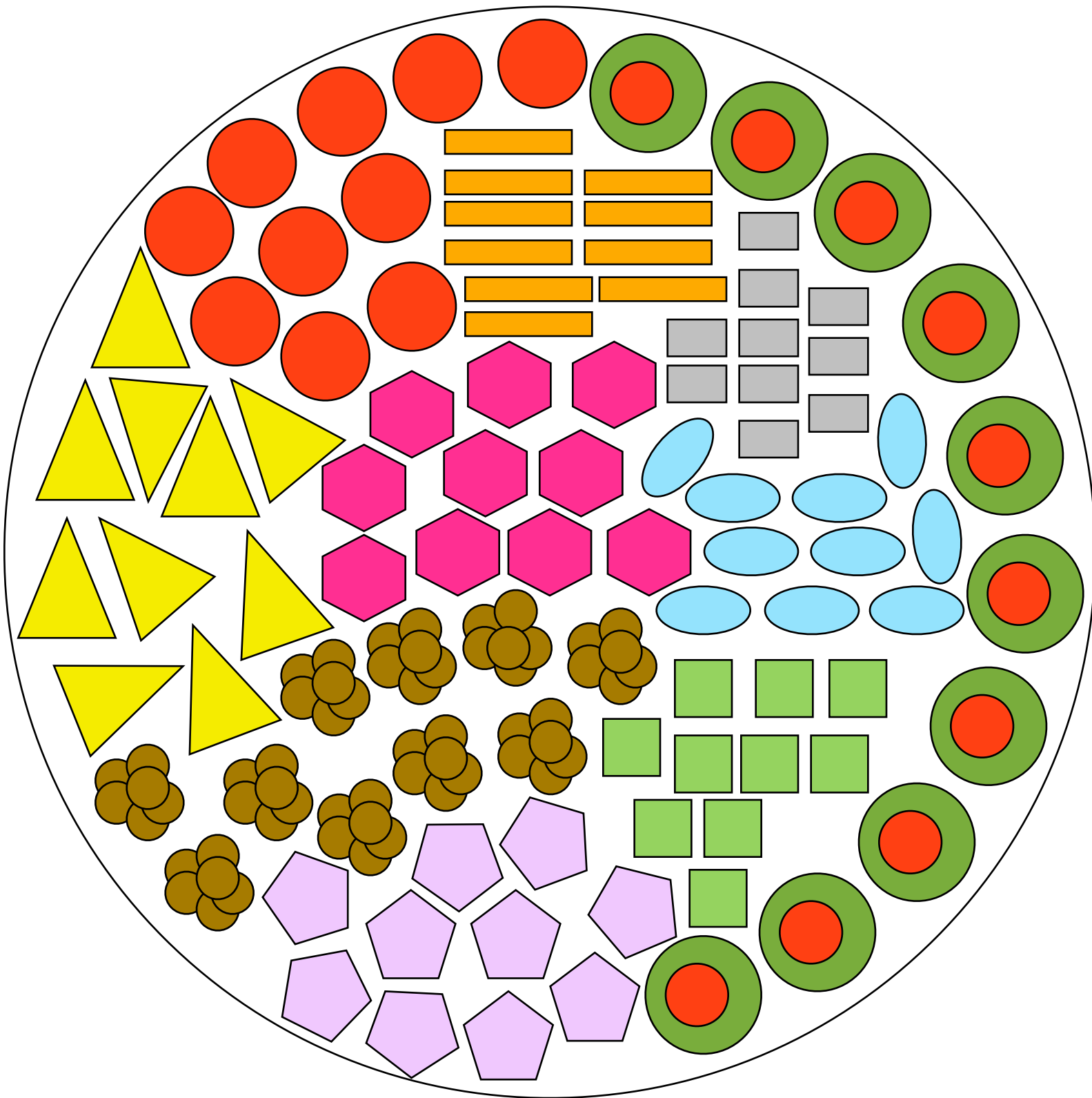
The pizzas will make a terrific bulletin board. Put them on an aluminum foil background so they look like they are baking in the oven.

Have students glue their pizza slice somewhere on the edge of their pizza crust.

To add more "keepsake" pizzazz, have students glue their school photo above the name of their pizza.

Older students may want to skip using my toppings and design their own on the blank pizza circle. Theirs could look more realistic. i.e. the mushrooms would look like a mushroom instead of a pentagram.

If you want to use as a sample.

crust, then trim into a circle shape.

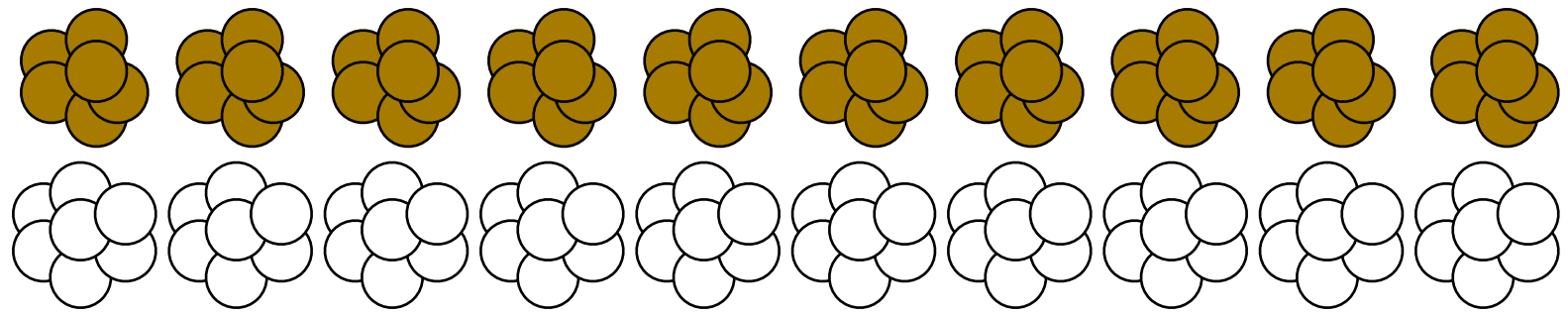
Have students name their pizza.

shapes with this pizza activity.

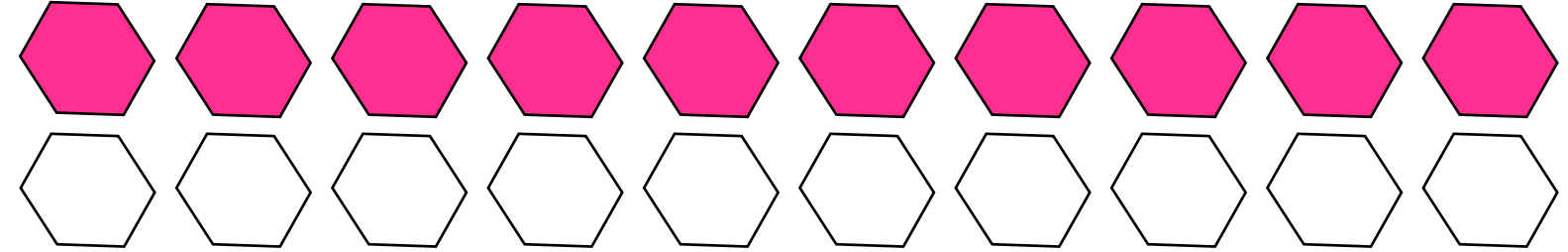

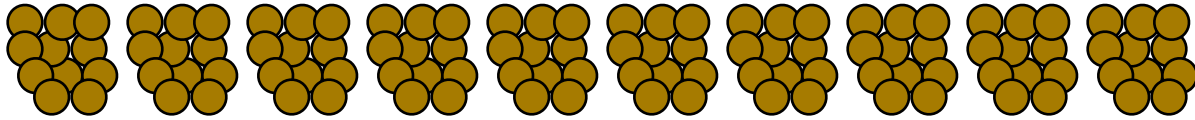
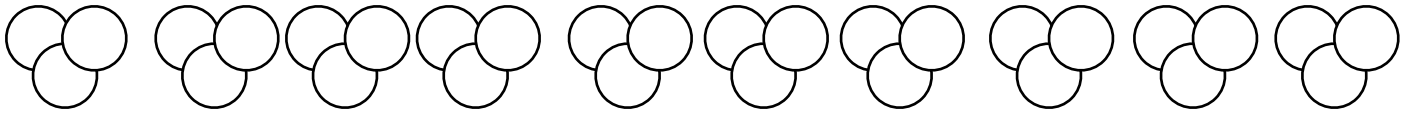


Cut and glue either the colored toppings or color, cut and glue the black and white toppings. Keep them in groups of 5's or 10's so you can easily count them to 100.

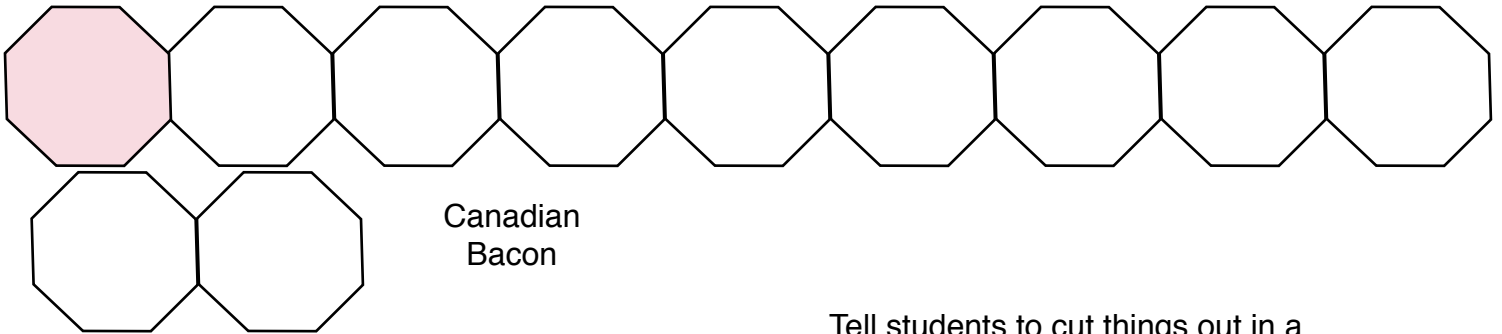
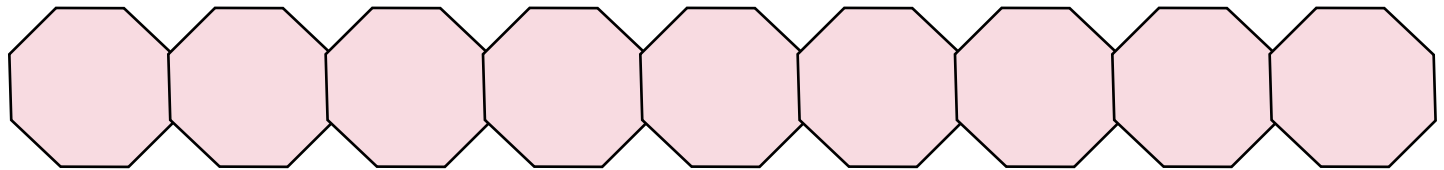
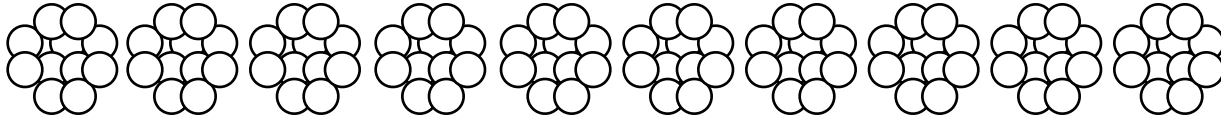

You may want to make the pizza circle bigger because of this trimming issue.

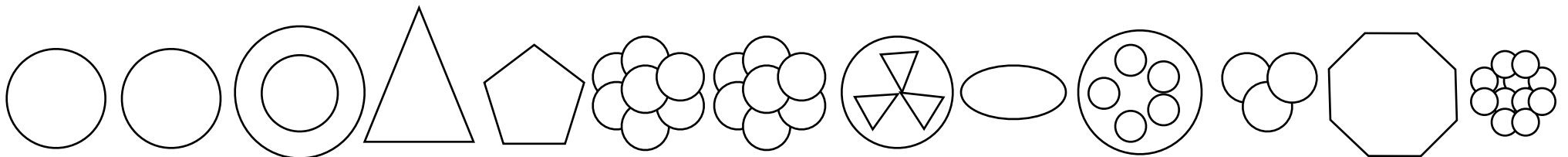
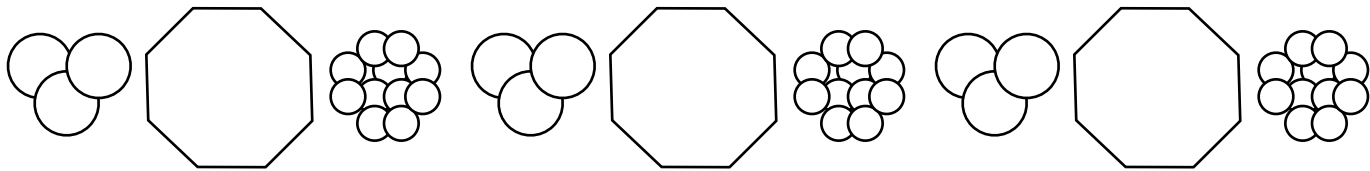
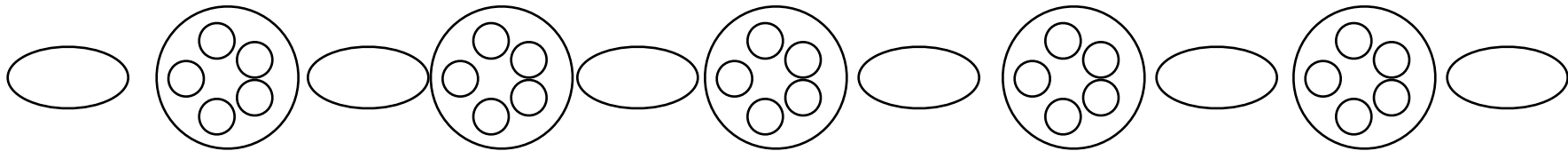
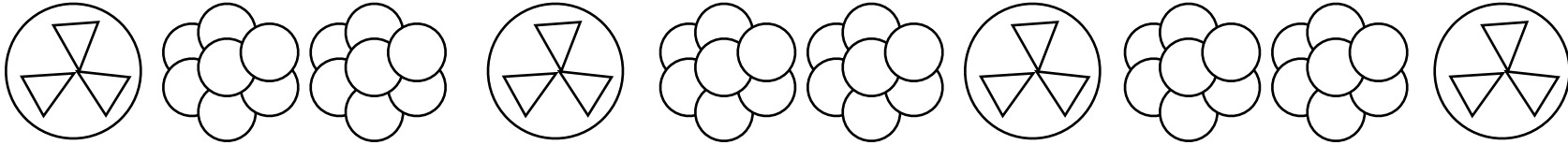
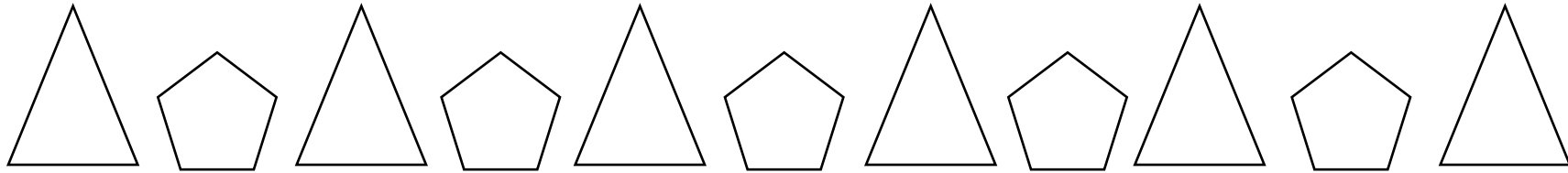
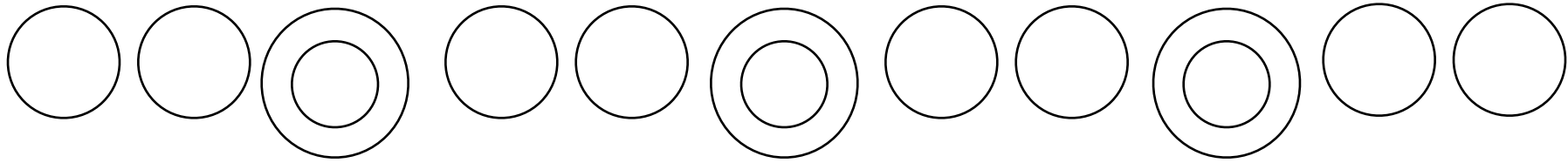
