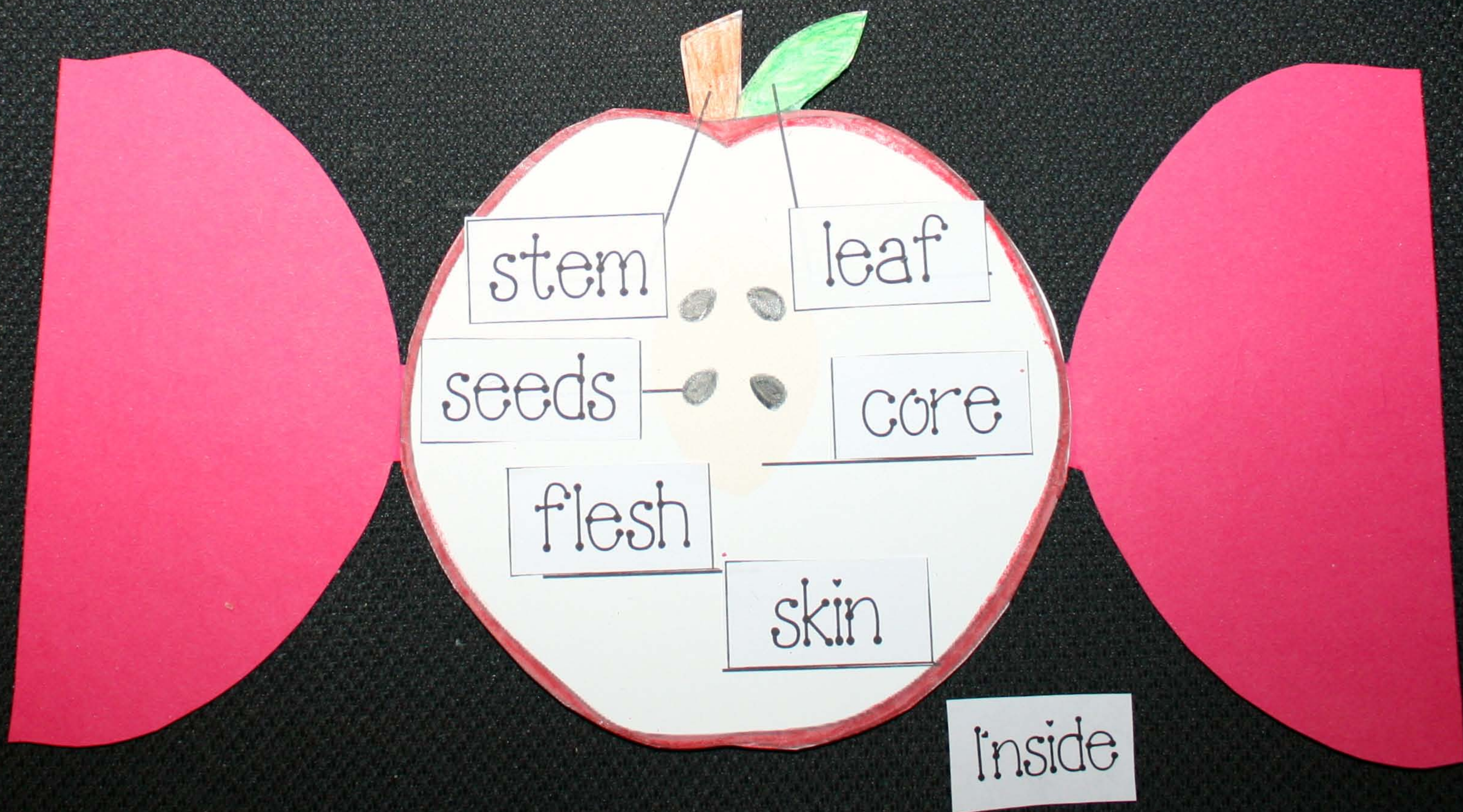


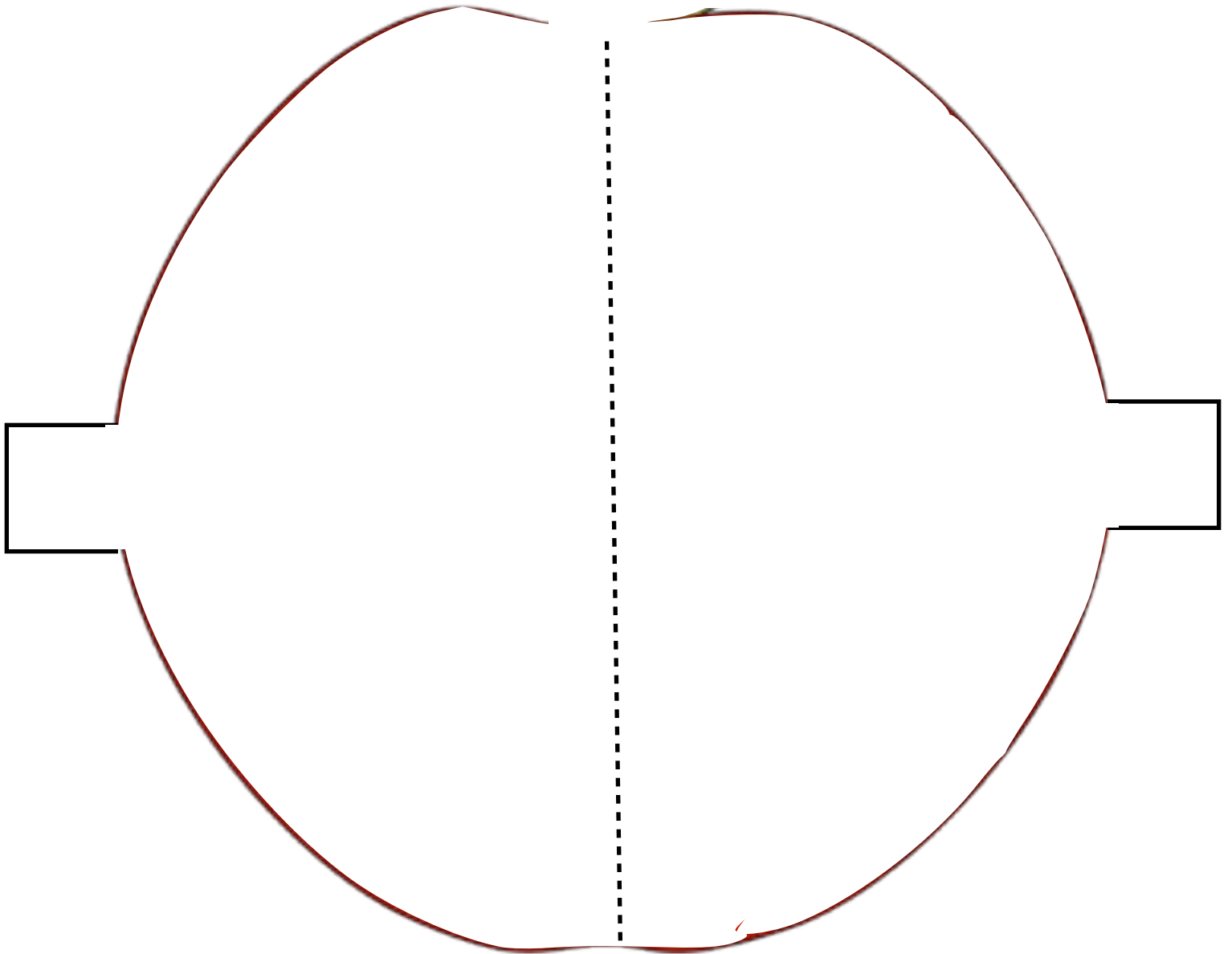

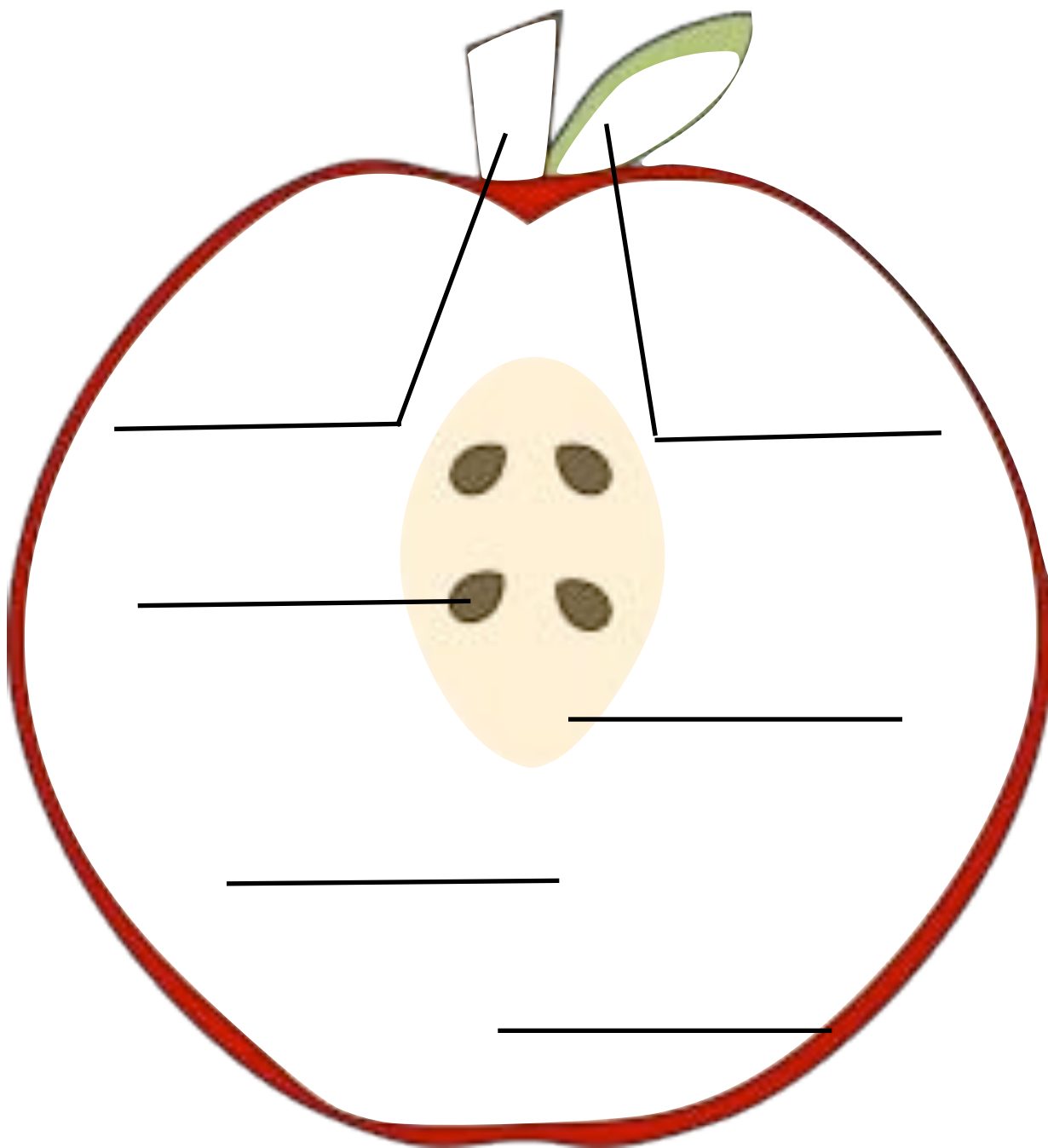

Run off on red, yellow and green construction paper.
Allow students to choose an apple and cut it out including cutting on the dashed line.
They glue the tabs to the back of the “core” apple so that their apple cover flips open like a book.
Students then label the parts of their apple.

Run off on white construction paper.
Students add a bit of color with crayons.
Older students can label their apples by writing on the appropriate lines; younger students can cut and glue the apple words.
Children write their name on the front cover.
When everyone is done, "read" the apple together, pointing to the words.
