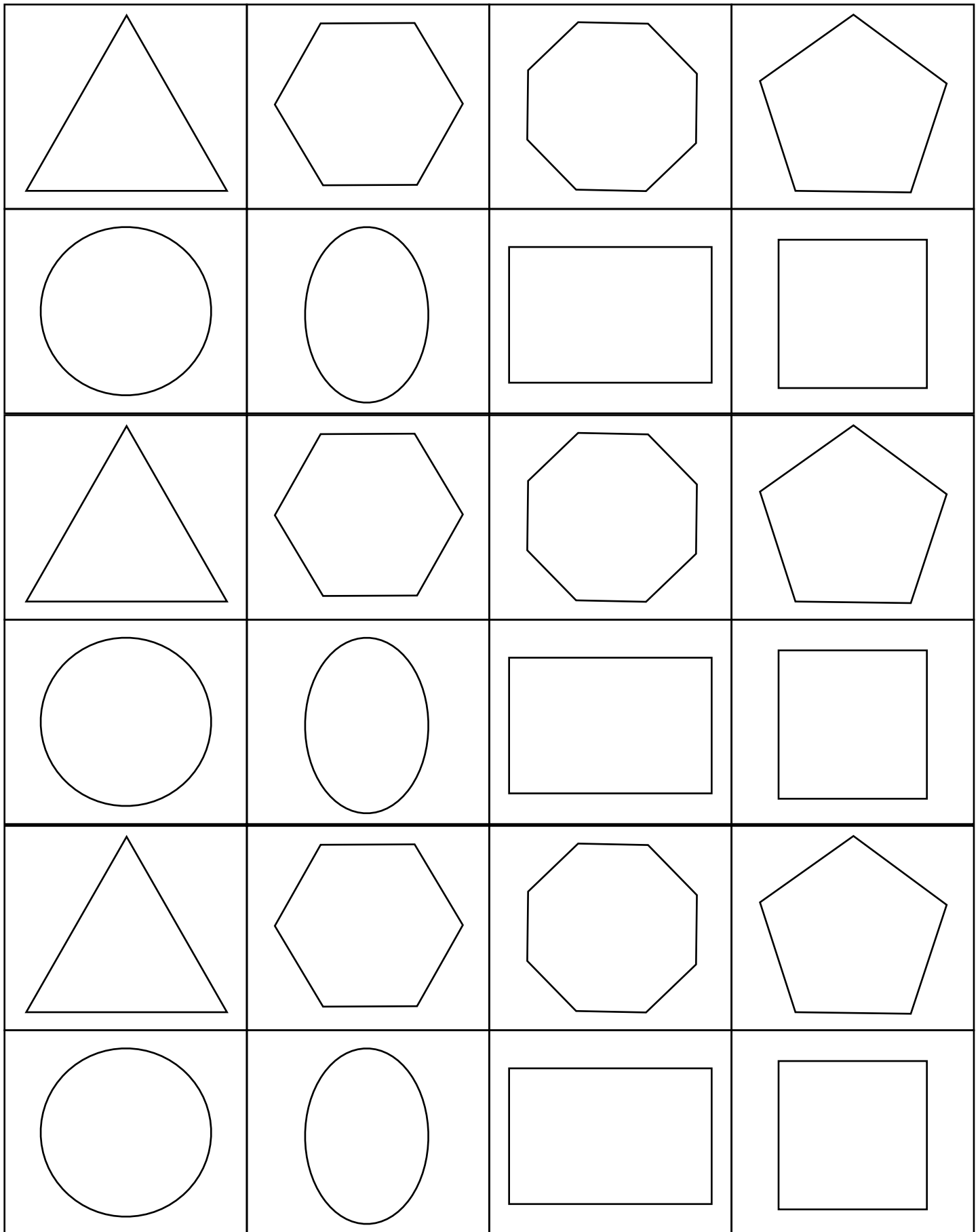

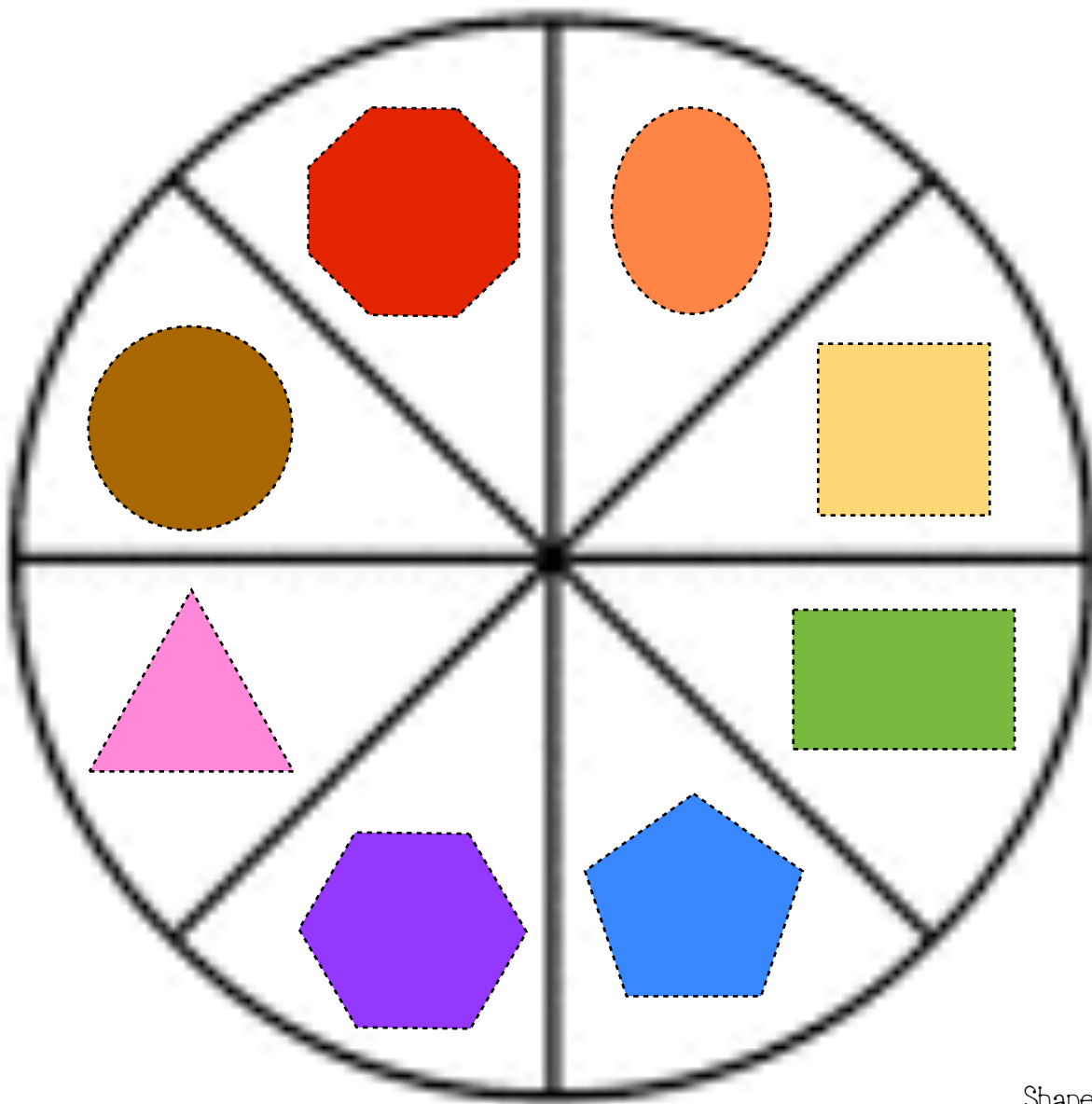

Print, laminate, trim.
Students place the shape tile onto the matching pilgrim card.

Print off on a variety of colors of construction paper. Laminate & trim. Students place a shape tile on the matching shape pilgrim card. Children can also use the tiles for patterning.





Shape Spinner

- Students can simply place the matching shape tiles onto the cards, or they can make a game out of it by using the shape spinner.
- Print, trim, glue to a piece of construction paper, trim, laminate.
- Using a protractor, poke a hole in the center.
- Using a brass brad, attach a large paperclip to the center.
- Children choose a partner and take turns spinning the shape spinner.
- Whatever shape they land on, they place the matching shape tile onto the twin shape card.
- The first one to complete their card is the winner.
- To reinforce colors, run off the cards on copy paper and don't laminate.
- Whatever color they spin, they color the matching shape that color.
- If you have a copy limit, you can laminate a set of color cards that students can color using dry erase markers.
