#### Plague of 1665-1666

In the year 1665, a deadly epidemic of bubonic plague struck the city of Leiden, causing the death of approximately 10,000 people.

The plague was brought to Leiden by a ship from the East Indies, which had been quarantined in the city. The disease spread rapidly, and many people died. The city was isolated, and the plague continued to spread.
