## Food:

Include where you went and what you saw. What was your favorite place that you went ?



## Travel Plans:

Include destination, why you chose this place, how you are going to get there, who you are going with, + departure and arrival dates and times.



## Activities:

Include the things you did or are planning to do.



## Preparations:

Include things you had to do to get the show on the road, what clothes you're going to wear, what things you're going to pack and why etc.



## Memories:

You're home again. What are your thoughts? How do you feel? Has the vacation changed you in any way?



## Arrival:

Include where you are staying, what that place looks like, and things you plan to do the first day.


