## Winter Writing Prompt

### Dangler

I got my textured white embossed paper out of a wallpaper sample book.

They have entire books of white embossed paper patterns.

Simply go to a paint, wallpaper, or home-center store, explain that you are a teacher and ask if you can have or buy their discontinued wallpaper books?

They are perfect for making banners, using them as backgrounds, cutting out die-cut letters, numbers and shapes, as well as using them in lieu of expensive scrapbook paper.

I used an 8" heavy duty paper plate. You can buy bulk at Sam's and Costco. I've also found them at The Dollar Store.

Trace around the plate to make a circle on the wallpaper and have students trim.

Children flip over the plate; rub glue all over it with a glue stick and then press their snowman head on the top.

Make templates of the hat, hat band, and facial pieces; trace them on the appropriate colors and have students cut out.

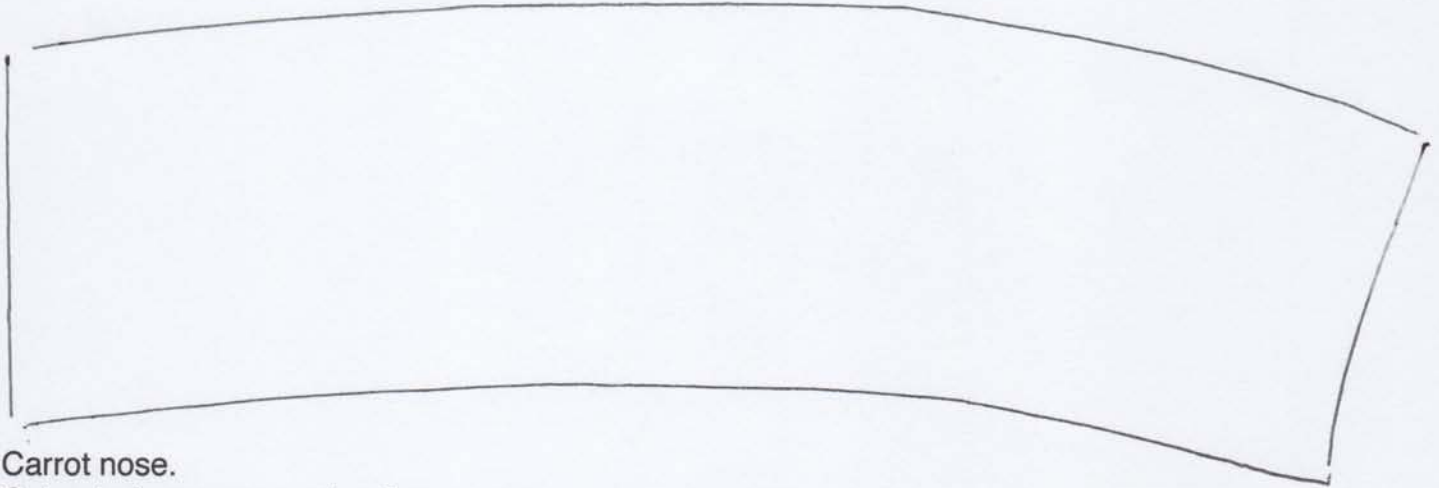
Add wiggle eyes, snowflake cut outs and glitter for those finishing touches.

Students choose a writing prompt, complete a final draft, write it on their circle, trim, and then glue to the center of the paper plate that is on the back of their snowman.

Punch a hole in the top and suspend from the ceiling.

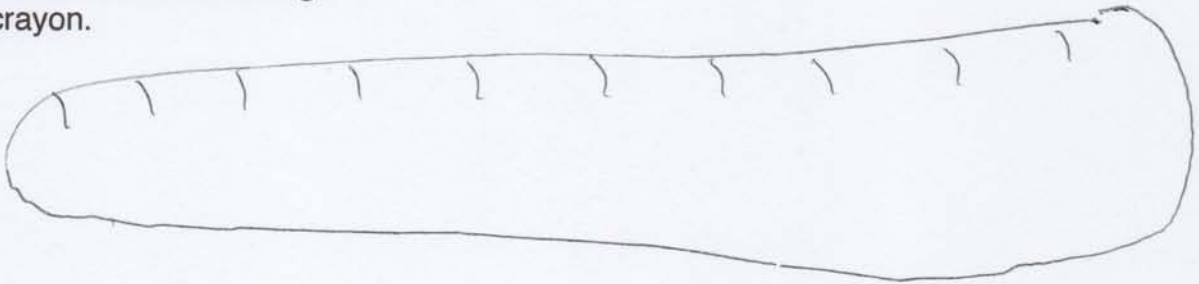
Hat band.

Carrot nose.

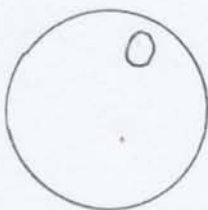
Cut out of orange construction paper.

marker or crayon.




Heart cheek. Cut out of red or pink

Add a dot of white for "sparkle."  
You can also use large wiggle eyes.
