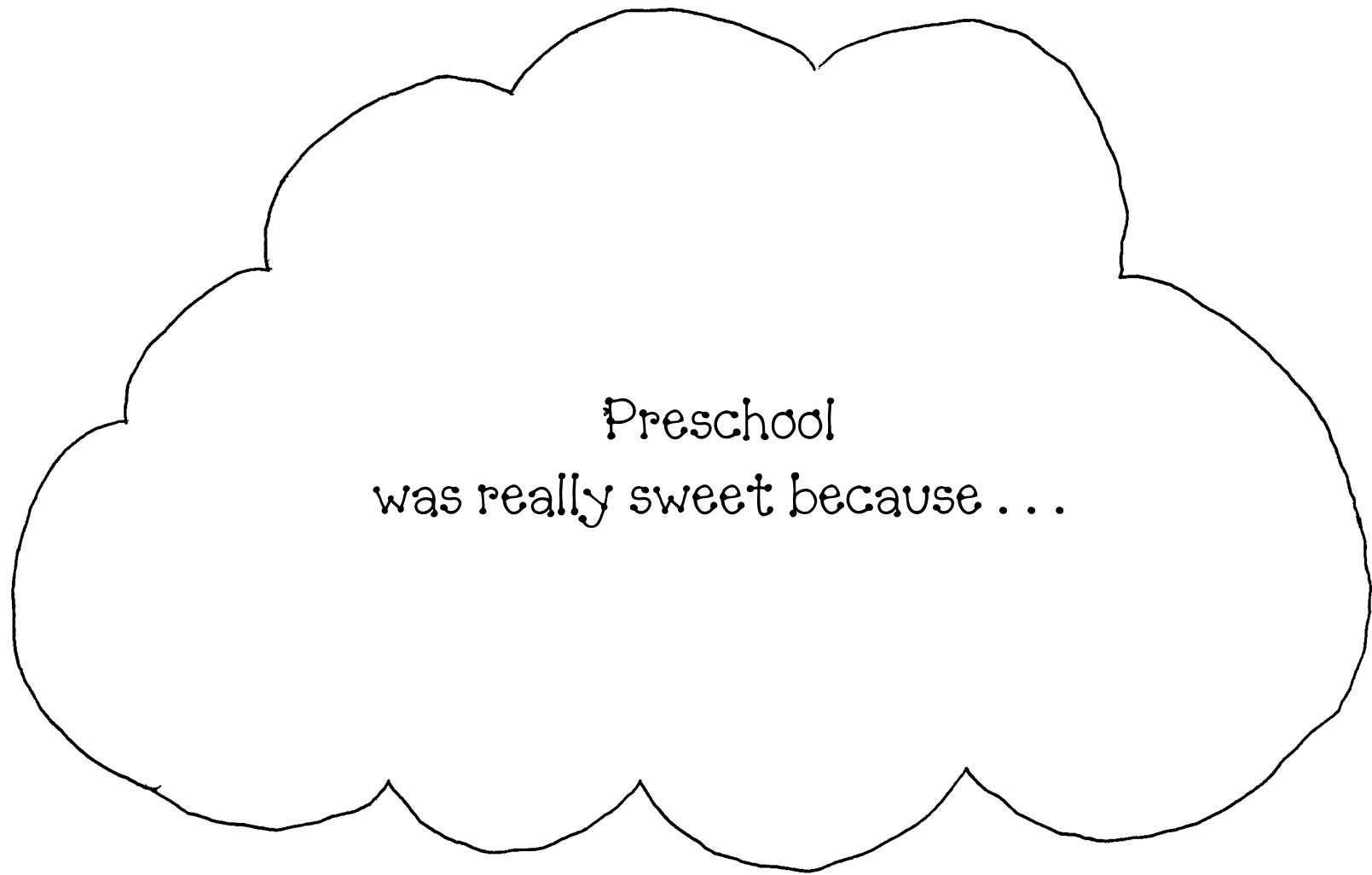


Run off on white construction paper. Students trim and glue to the top of their cupcake liner.

Run off on a variety of colors of construction paper. Students trim and “hinge” to the top of their cupcake so that it flips open. They complete the writing prompt underneath.

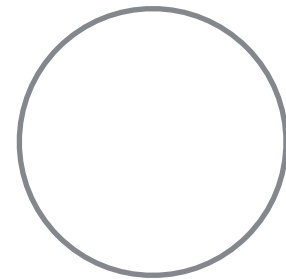
