## Thinking About Summer!

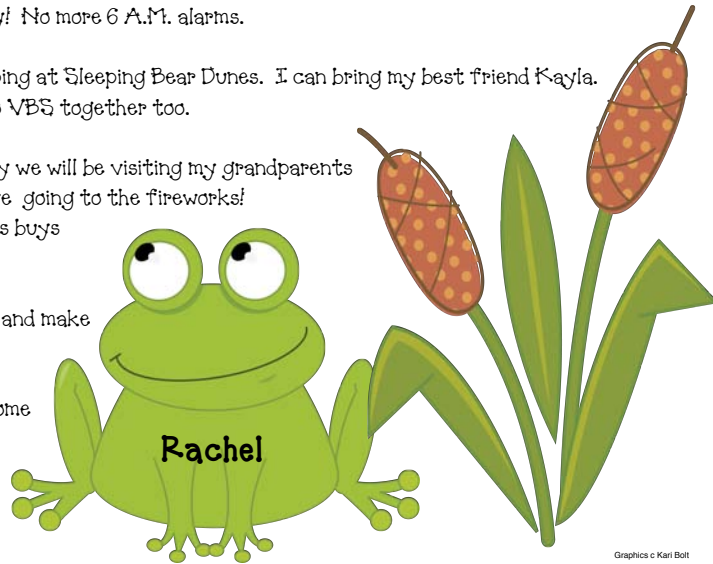
I can't wait for summer vacation! We will be getting out of school June 10th. I'm excited about staying up late and sleeping in. Yay! No more 6 A.M. alarms.

June 10th can't come fast enough.

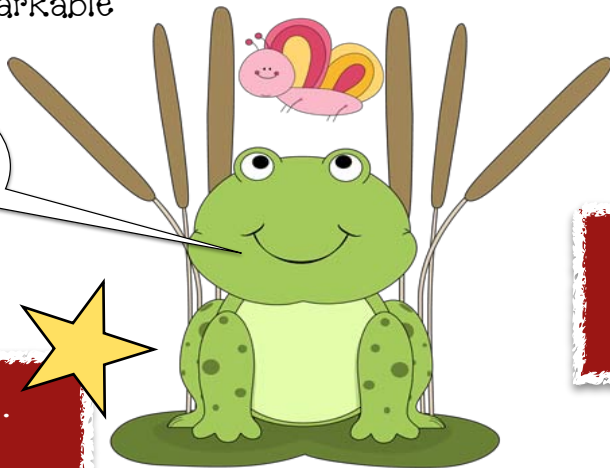

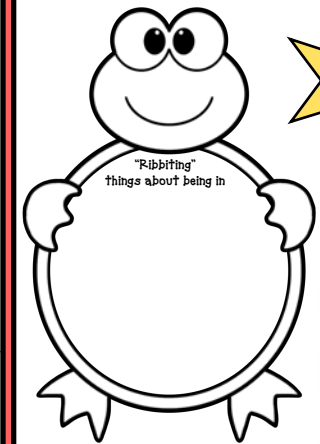

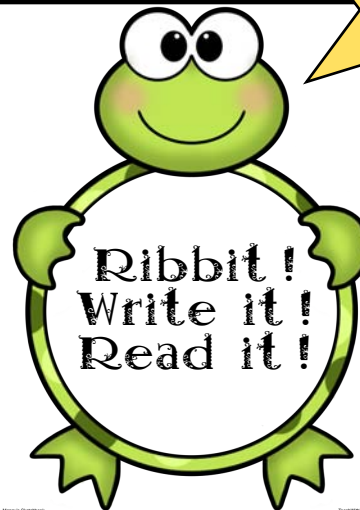

# "This Stuff Stuck! Look What I Learned!" Writing Prompt

These are a few of my favorite things that I learned in kindergarten.

I learned the alphabet, and how to identify upper and lowercase letters.

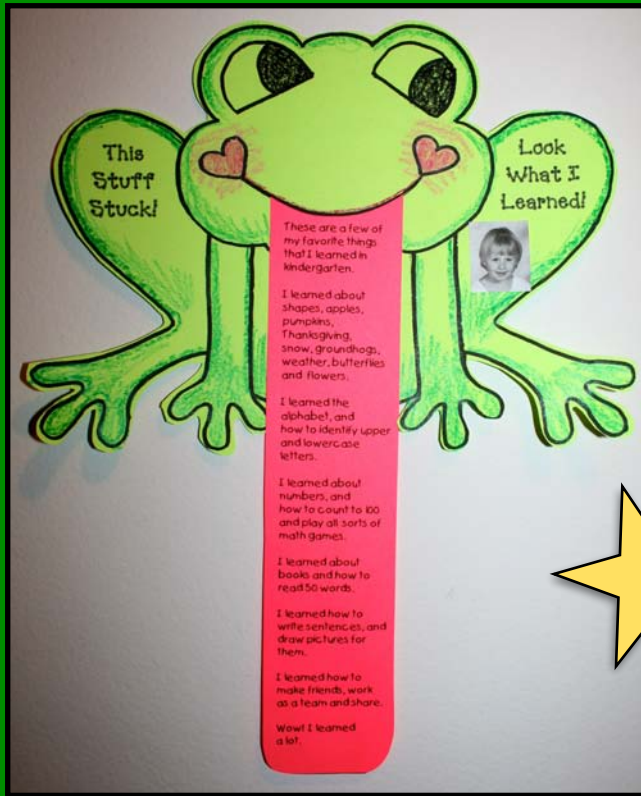
I learned about numbers, and how to count to 100 and play all sorts of math games.

Wow! I learned a lot.

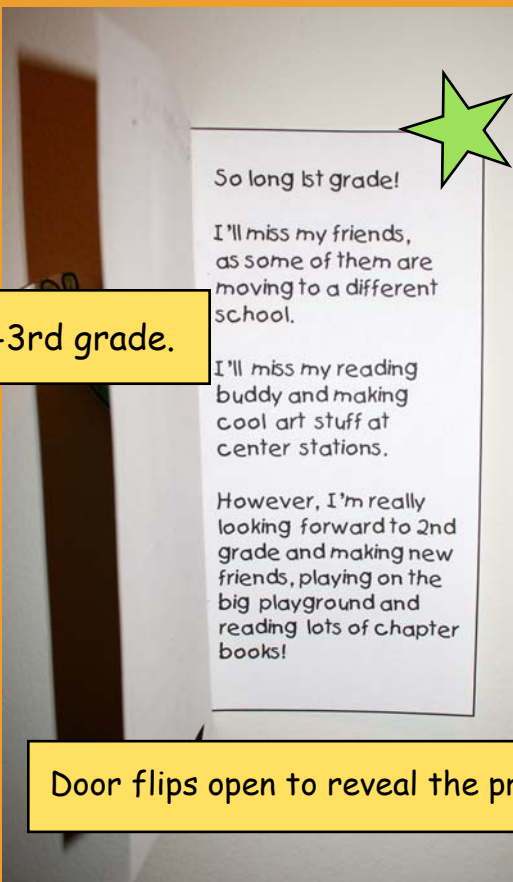

Door flips open to reveal the prompt.

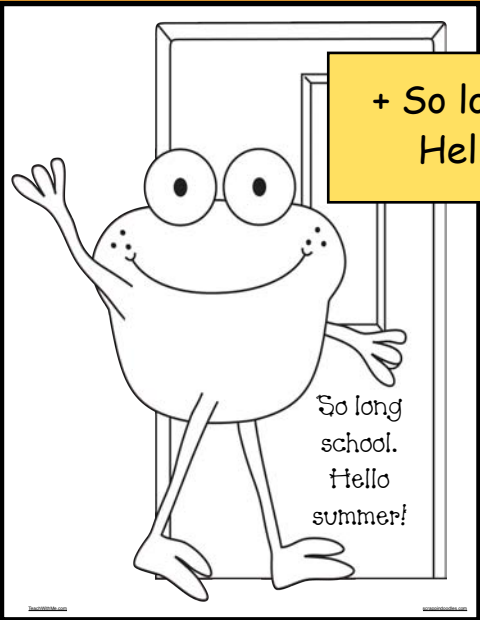
Choose a writing prompt for your students, or have them think up one of their own.

Students can write about the things they'll miss, then end with what they are really looking forward to in their new grade.

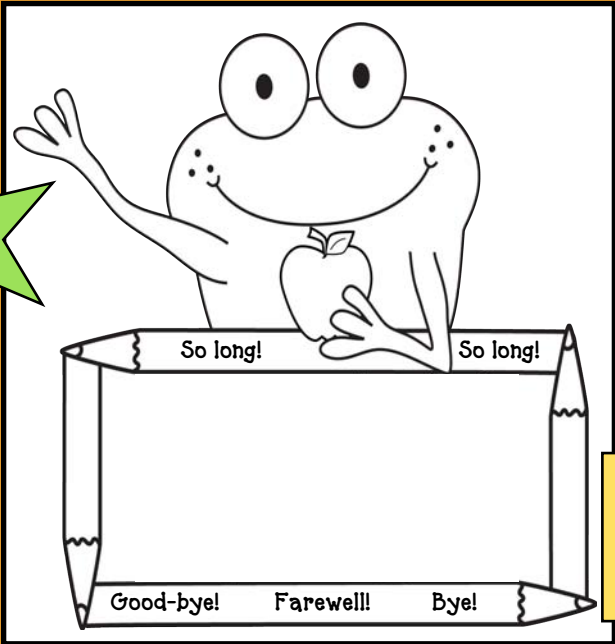
You could also make this a memory book. Have students write their favorite:
