How many ways can you make a dollar?


This is a half dollar.

You need two of these coins to make a dollar.




This is a quarter.

quarter \_\_\_\_\_

It is worth twenty-five cents.

twenty-five cents 25 \_\_\_\_\_

You need four of these coins to make a dollar.



This is a dime.


dime \_\_\_\_\_

It is worth ten cents.

ten cents 10 \_\_\_\_\_

You need ten of these coins to make a dollar.

Count them by 10s.



This is a nickel.


nickel \_\_\_\_\_

It is worth five cents.

five cents 5 \_\_\_\_\_

You need twenty of these coins to make a dollar.

Count them by 5s.



This is a penny.

penny \_\_\_\_\_

It is worth one cent.

one cent 10 \_\_\_\_\_

You need one hundred of these coins to make a dollar.

Count the groups by 10s.



You can combine the coins in a variety of ways to make a dollar.

For example: 2 quarters + 1 half dollar = a dollar
