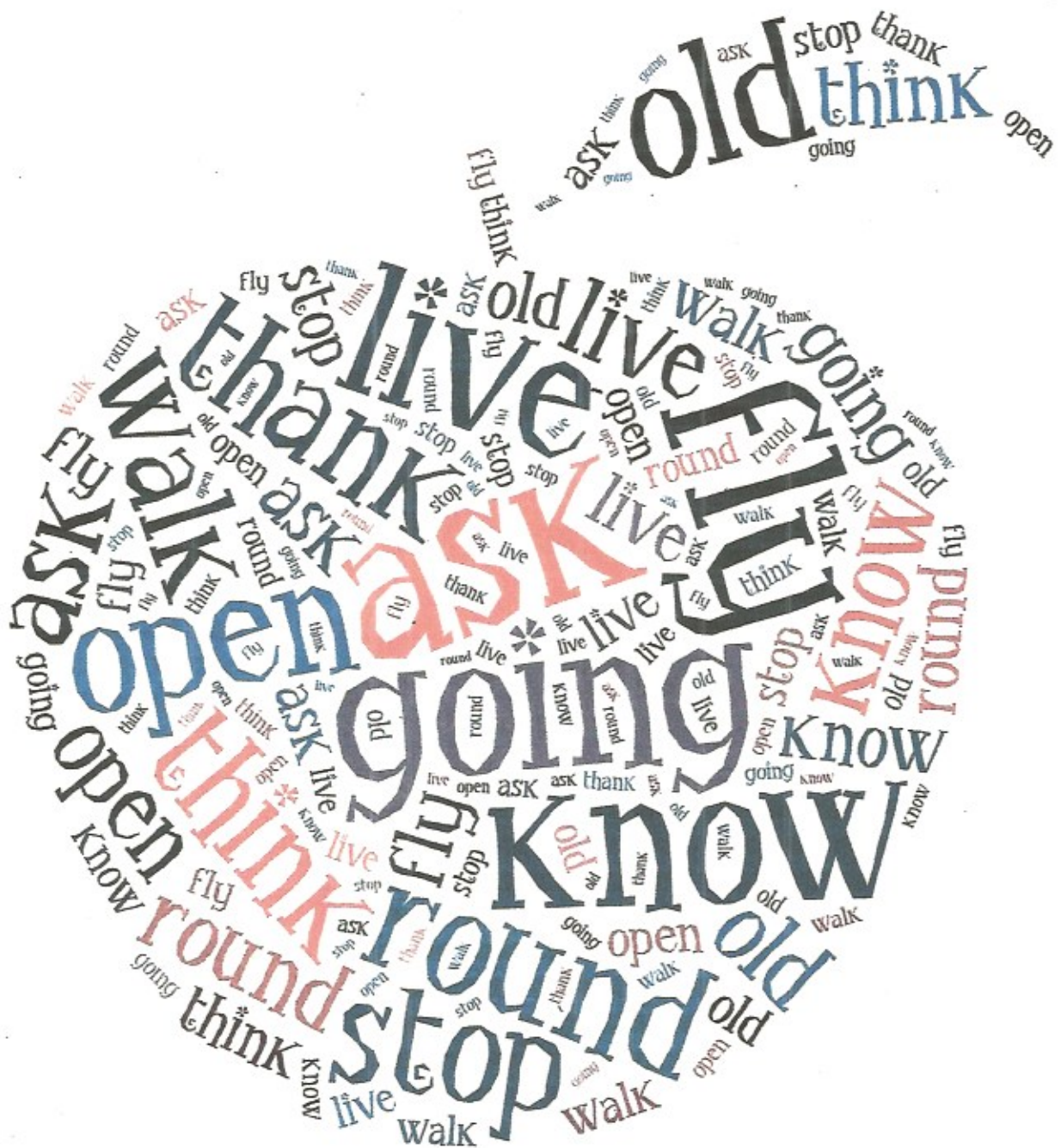

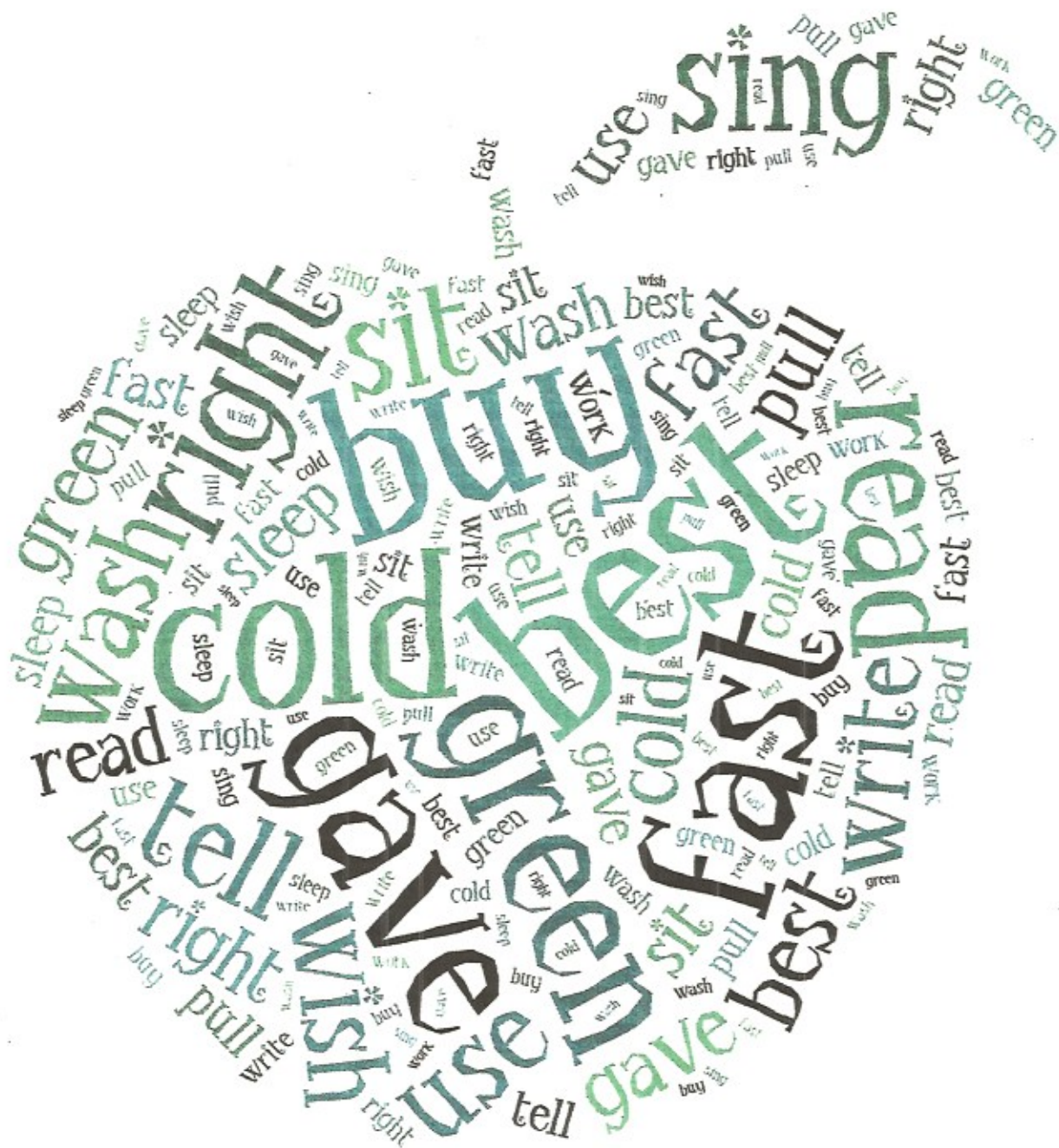

It's a website that turns words, famous speeches, poems, quotes, etc. into a VISUALLY stunning word cloud.

The possibility of ideas is endless.

The site is simple to use, so that even K students can be shown how to type in a list of words and create a special piece of art to be the cover of a card.

Brainstorm a list of words with students; write them on the board, students choose the ones appropriate for them and type them in.

These are two that I made for Mother's Day. You can use mine, or have students describe their mom and make their own.

Different fonts, colors and shapes are available to choose from.

Another activity that you could do is having students make up a list of adjectives that describe them.

Students make a word picture about themselves entitled "ME".

Run off copies of the various word pictures and have students “spy” the words in the collage.

Have them jot down the words as they find them and then, for another activity, students can alphabetize their list.

Have students make tally marks next to each word to see how many times they found it in the word picture to reinforce another standard as well!

I also thought it would be cute to make a graduation certificate using those themed-words.



It's also a great way to plug in new vocabulary as it relates to the various science themes that you study, like butterflies.
