## Chicka Boom Handprint Palm

### Materials:

- Large blue construction paper
- Brown textured wall paper or brown construction paper
- Green construction paper
- Brightly colored Ellison Die cut letters, or run off my templates on colored paper, or buy foam stick alphabet letters.
- Glue sticks
- Scissors
- **Optional:** hole punch and fish line or yarn if you are going to hang in the hallway and suspend from the ceiling.


### Directions:

#### Prep:

- Make a palm template: Textured wallpaper looks fantastic for this. I ask wallpaper stores like Sevens if they have any, they usually give them free to teachers. Some stores, like Menards, sell them for \$2-\$3.
- Make a template out of cardstock and then trace it on the wallpaper for students to cut out. Or...
- Run off palm trunk master on brown construction paper.
- Have a room helper trace the students' hands ONCE and then cut 3 prints.
- You could also send the paper home with students and have parents do this step.
- Make a copy of your class composite and cut students' face in the shape of an oval, so they can glue it on the coconut on the bottom of the page.
- Make an extra copy so you have their picture for the last page of their booklet entitled: ***There's Enough Room***
- **Optional:** Pre-sort and bag up letters for students' names to expedite project.

#### The next day...

1. Students CUT out their palm trunk.
2. Children GLUE their trunk to the bottom-middle of the paper.
3. Demonstrate this step so that you have a sample.
4. Show students how you placed the three handprints so they "flair" out.
5. Younger children will need help with this step.
6. Make sure the left and right hands have the thumbs facing down in the middle of the trunk.
7. I cut the thumb off of the 3<sup>rd</sup> print and glue that in the center of the other two.
8. Read the words ***Chicka Chicka Boom Boom*** with the students and show them where to glue the 3 coconuts.
9. You might want to review the science fact that coconuts grow in "clusters".
10. Children cut and glue the Chicka Boom coconuts in a cluster and the single coconut to the bottom of the page.
11. Students glue their photo to the coconut.










### Materials:

- Brightly-colored markers
- Glue sticks


### Directions:

#### Prep:

- Run off the masters.
- Print a copy of your class composite on the photo setting of your copier.
- Cut the students pictures into ovals.
- Print off the big letters so they can glue their initial to that page.
- If you have students who have a lot of the same initial, you can make your own template. I used STENCIL font at 180 pica and then selected different colors from the menu bar.

#### The next day...

1. Children select several colors of markers (I like to use a different color for each letter. Students who have really long names can repeat the rainbow pattern.)
2. Students trace the letters of the sentences. So they won't get bored, I tell them to use a variety of colors.
3. Print off my sample, or make one of your own. Show them the sample.
4. Demonstrate how to write their name on the coconut tree.
