These little counting books give you lots of “bang for your time!”

- Students READ the number as a number and as a word.
- Students trace the number and word.
- They write the number and word.
- They read and see that many of “something” in a sentence.
- They spy that number in a sequence of numbers and CIRCLE that number.
- They X that many boxes. Students can also bingo dot or stamp that many boxes.
- Students cut and glue the group/set to the matching numbered boxes.
- When everyone has finished their booklet, read it aloud as a whole group and review concepts of print.
- Children will be able to take these booklets home and share them with their families.
- These are great self-esteem builders.
- You can do a page a day or an entire booklet.
- Children only need to do one of these booklets with assistance and then be able to do them independently; a different one each week or month according to your needs and themes.
- It’s a great way to learn how to identify and read numbers and number words and cover a variety of skills and standards!

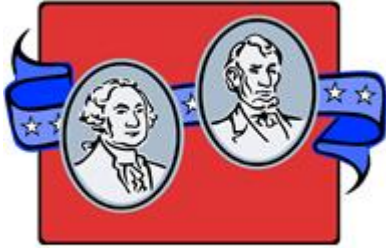

Editors note: The jury is out on whether to capitalize president or not, depending on it's usage. I was taught that if it refers to the President of the United States, whether his name follows or not, it should be capitalized.

However, newspaper and journalists have set a different norm since the 1970's, and various manuals do not agree either. I've read countless Google searches and found no real "authority." You may want to do some research yourself, so you can teach your students appropriately.

If you decide to capitalize the p in the booklet, simply use it as a teachable moment to have students cross out the lowercase p and write an uppercase p above it.
