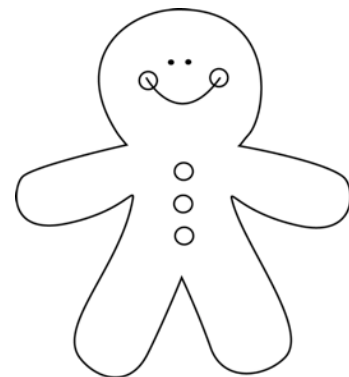
Skip Counting A Pattern

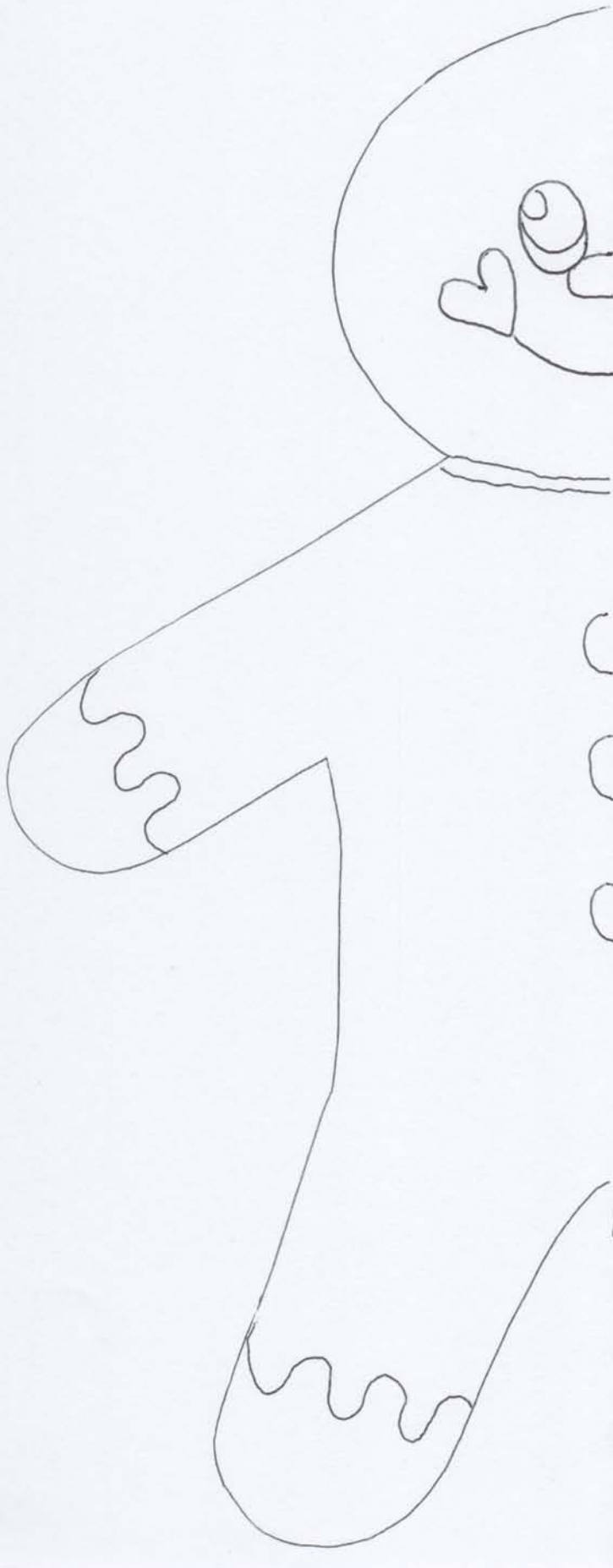
Listening And Following Directions Gingerbread
