Easy Candy Corn Fractions
Print, trim and trace onto an old file folder, then cut out. Use this template to trace once on orange construction paper and cut out 3-6 circles at a time.

If you want to do this activity with PK kids, the most difficult thing for them will be to glue the yellow circle to the MIDDLE of this orange one and get it centered. To help them I designed this template that you can run off on orange paper. They then glue their yellow circle in the middle.




Run off on white copy paper.
Students trim and lay on top of their 3-color circle.
They cut on the lines to make candy corn fractions.
Have students write numbers, letters, CVC words, (whatever you're working on) on the various sections.
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Tou can simply do the candy corn craft and leave it at that, but if you're also studying fractions use these pocket cards for a fun review.
