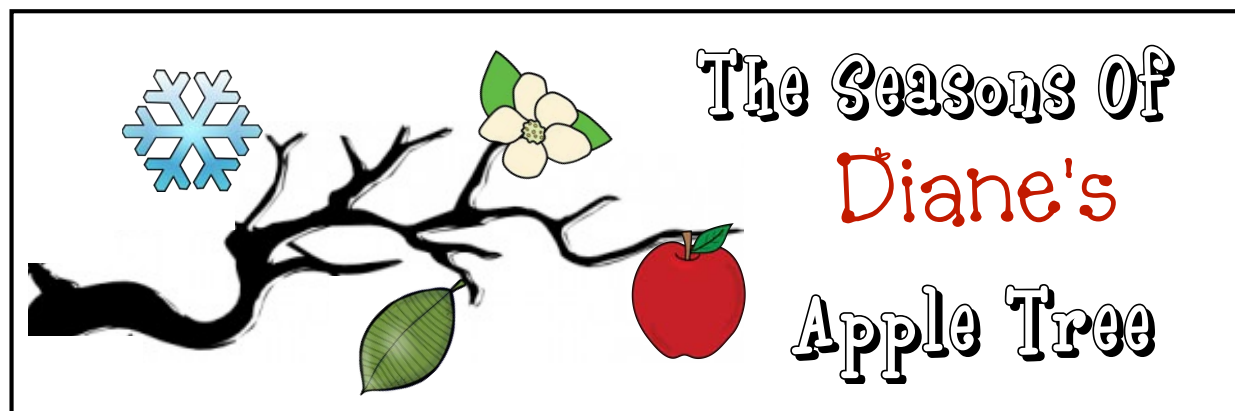


FYI Seasonal Tree Branch
