



Run the letter "sliders" off.

Children trim, trace the letters, then glue the strips together.

I've included blank strips to glue to either end, so it's easier for children to pull the letter "slider" through the "window" to make words.

Read all of the words together as a whole group activity.

Play "I Spy". Call out a word, children slide to it.

Run the chick template off on yellow construction paper. Students color the beak and legs.

If you want a little 3D pizzazz, add mini wiggle eyes and a beak.


To make a beak cut squares of orange construction paper.

Students fold in half and glue the bottom "triangle section" to the beak on the paper. The top part flips up to look like the chick is peeping.

You can also fold the wings forward as well.

Students write their name on the chick's tummy.
