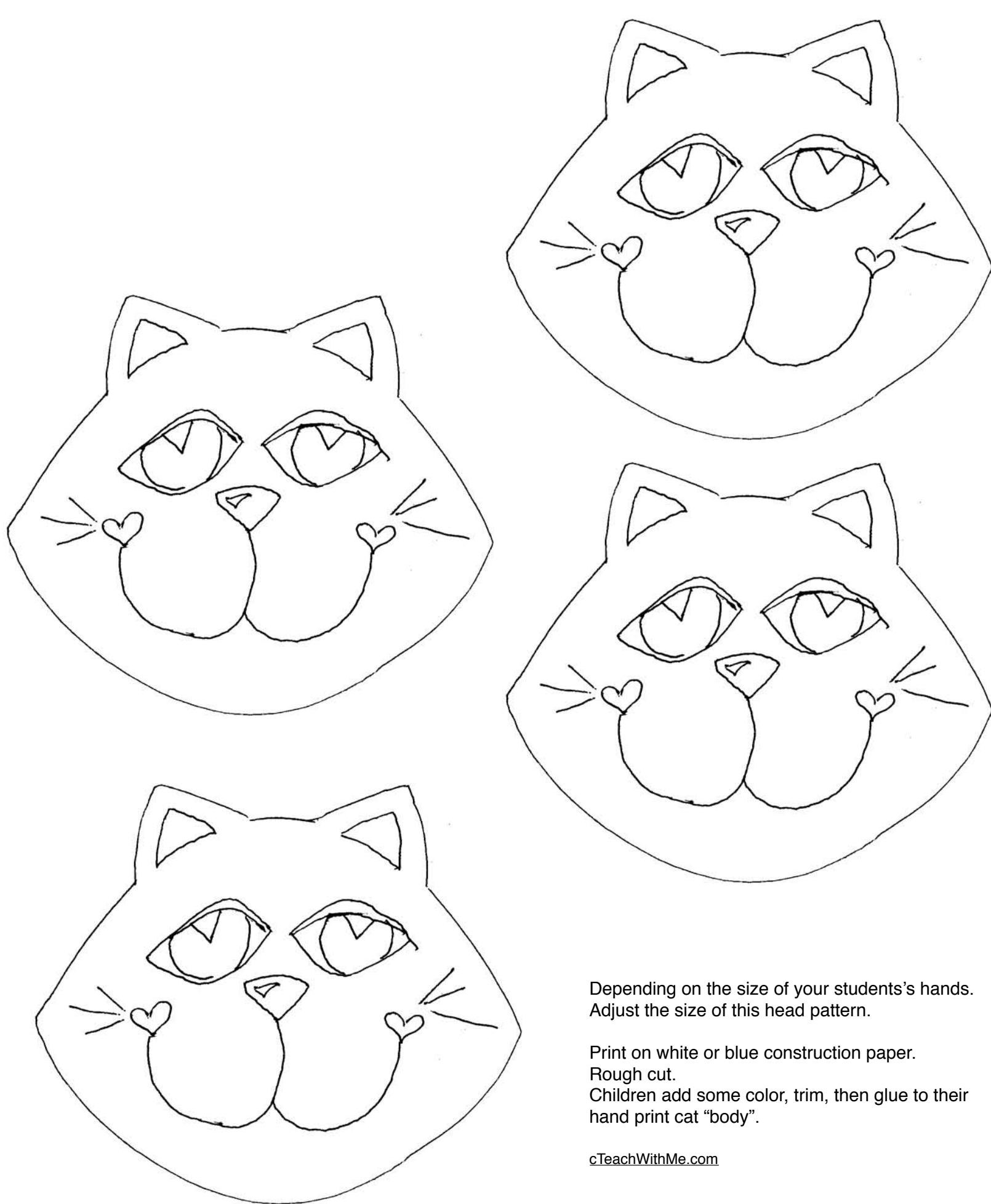



Depending on the size of your students's hands.

Print on white or blue construction paper.
Rough cut.
Children add some color, trim, then glue to their
hand print cat "body".

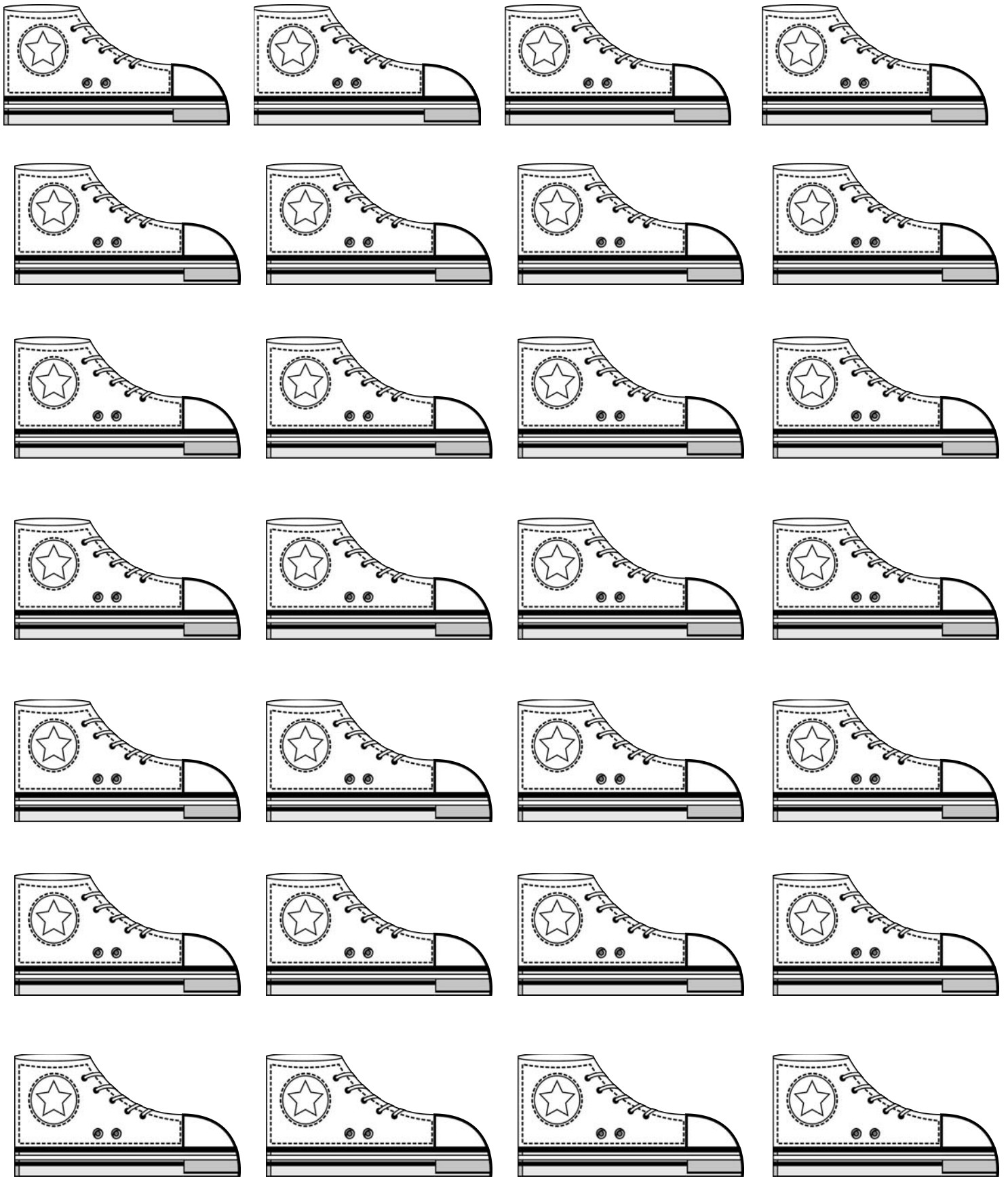

Run off on pink and red construction paper.


Rough cut.

for even more keepsake value.



Run off on white, red, blue and brown construction paper. Each child gets one of every color so they can retell the story "I Love My White Shoes". These can be pre-cut for PK kiddos.

Pete's shoes got wet!

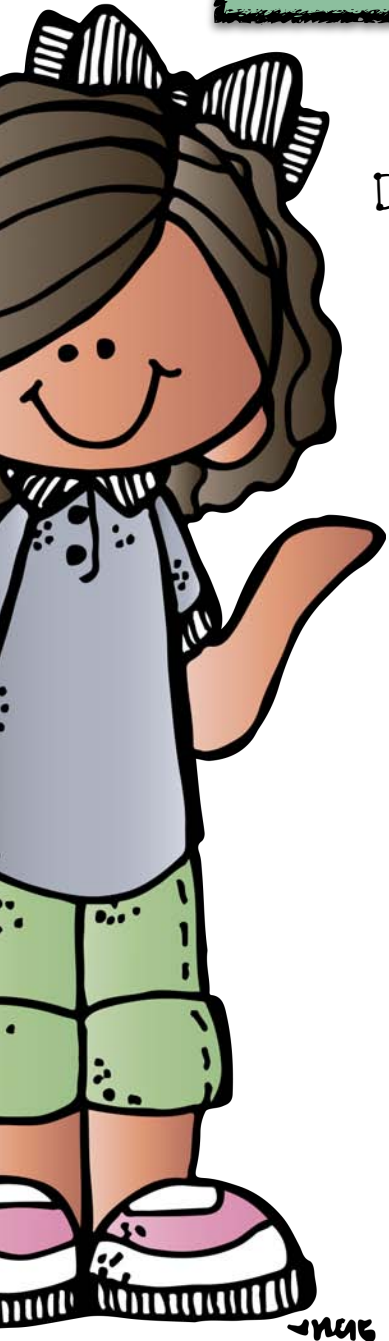
