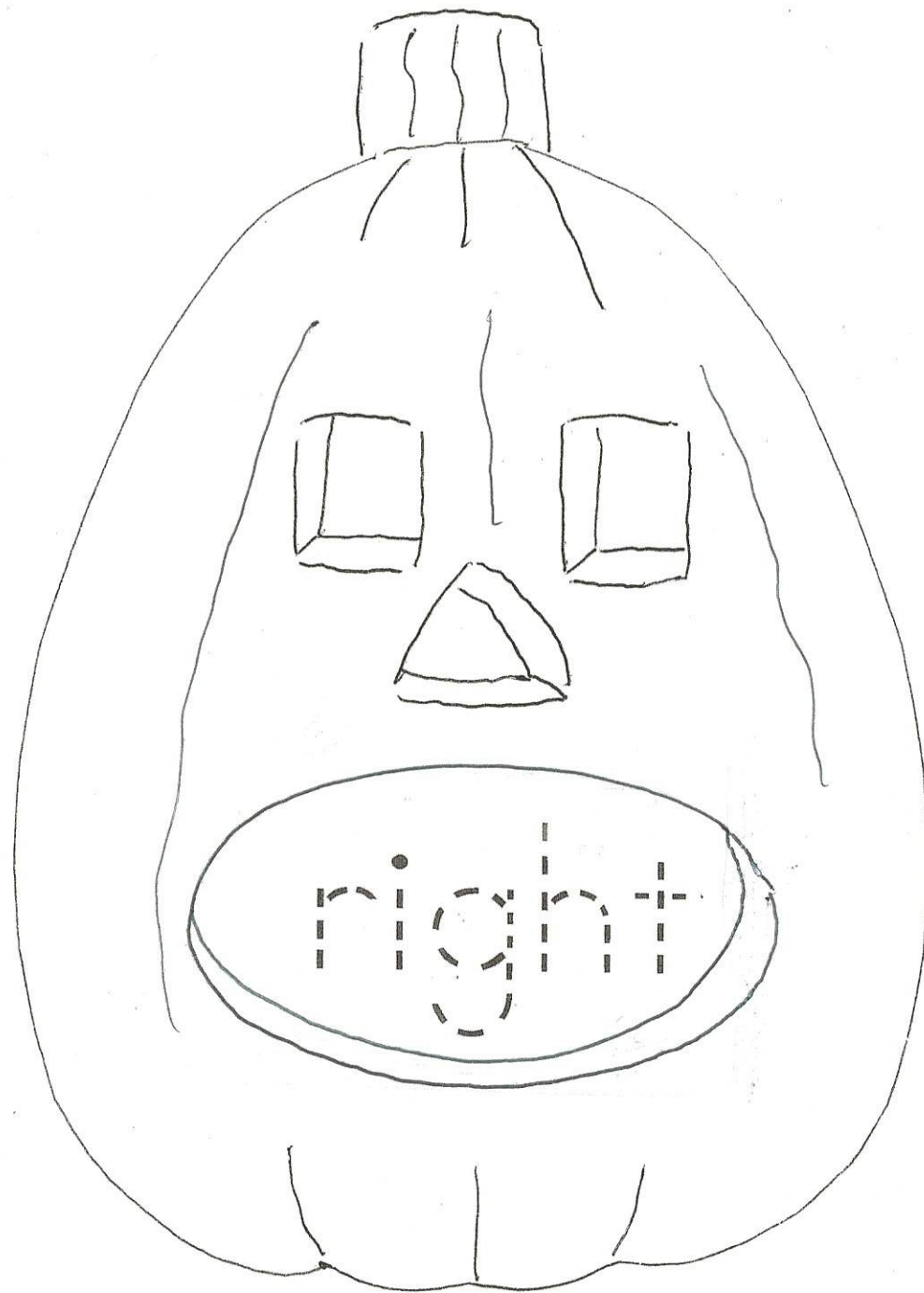
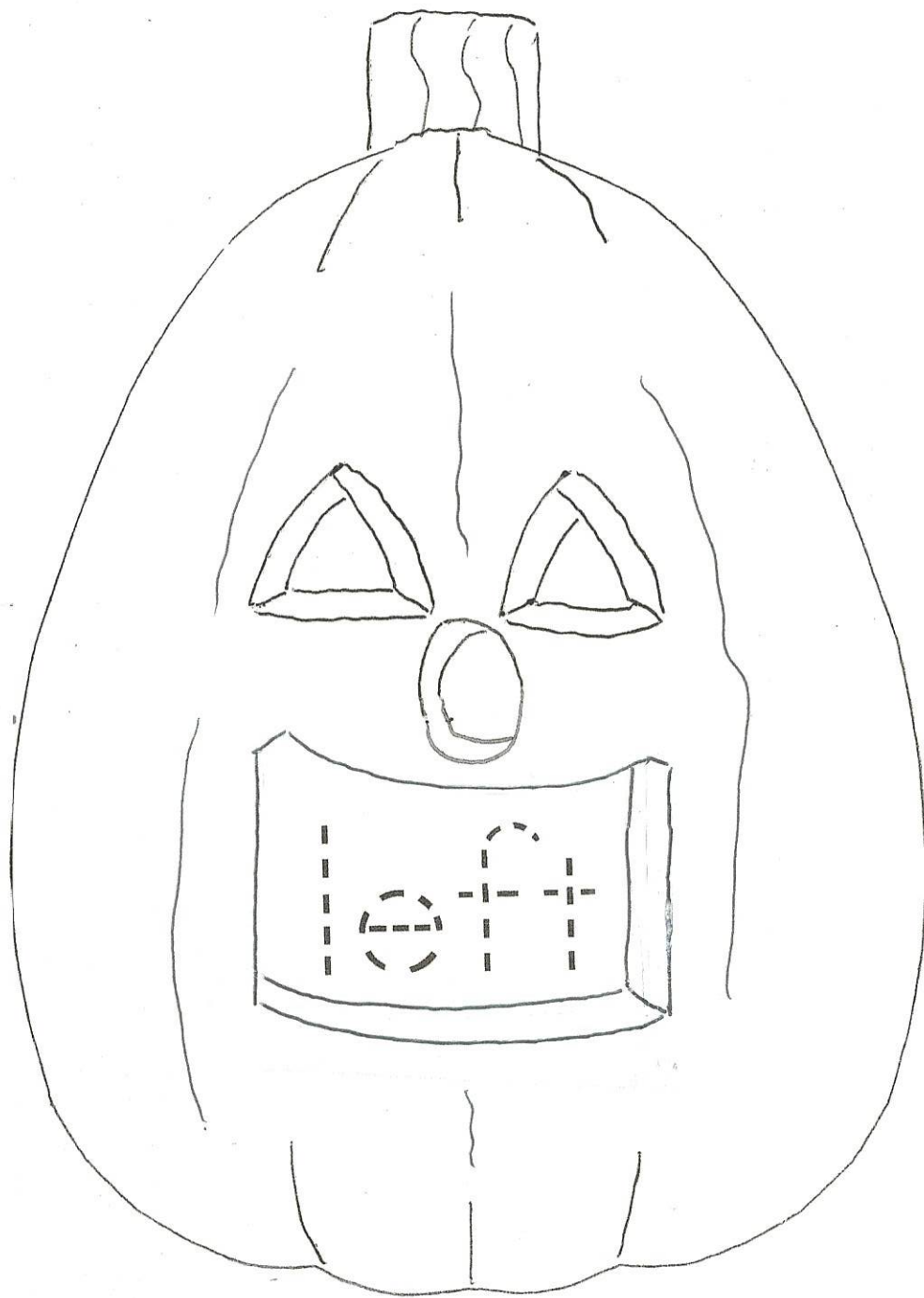
## Pumpkin Left or Right Paddle

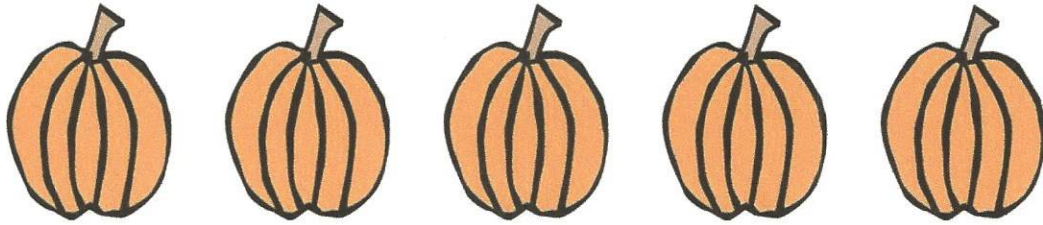
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### Directions:

1. Run the master off on yellow and orange construction paper.
2. Cut the sheets in half.
3. Some students will have a yellow right and an orange left and some will have the opposite.
4. It is important that they have two different colors as this helps younger children differentiate better.
5. Children cut out their pumpkins
6. Students color their pumpkins with crayons adding details. (See my samples.)
7. It's a good idea for you to make a sample as well, to model and show your students what to do.
8. Students TRACE the words left & right inside the pumpkin's mouth.
9. Teacher tapes a large Popsicle stick to one side of a child's pumpkin.
10. Student rubs glue all over the back of the other pumpkin and then presses it to the Popsicle pumpkin so the two pumpkins are back-to-back.
11. Child or teacher writes name on one side of the Popsicle stick.
12. Teacher can ask a variety of questions.
13. Children will respond by showing the appropriate side of their Popsicle stick pumpkin.
14. Here are some sample questions:
  - Are you right or left handed?
  - Is our door on the right or left side of the room?
  - Are our windows on the right or left side of the room?
  - Is the teacher's desk on the right or left side of the room?
  - Pick out items that are either right or left as your students look at them.
  - You can also draw a line down the white board.
  - Show the children, which side is left and which side is right.
  - Place seasonal magnets on the various sides, and then as then which side the pumpkin magnet is on etc.





**Let's draw pumpkins to the left and pumpkins to the right.**

1. Draw 1 pumpkin on the left and 2 on the right.
2. Draw 2 pumpkins on the left and 3 on the right.
3. Draw 3 pumpkins on the left and 4 on the right.
4. Add up all of your pumpkins on the left.  
How many do you have on the left?
5. Add up all of your pumpkins on the right.  
How many pumpkins do you have?
6. Now add all of your pumpkins.  
How many pumpkins do you have?
