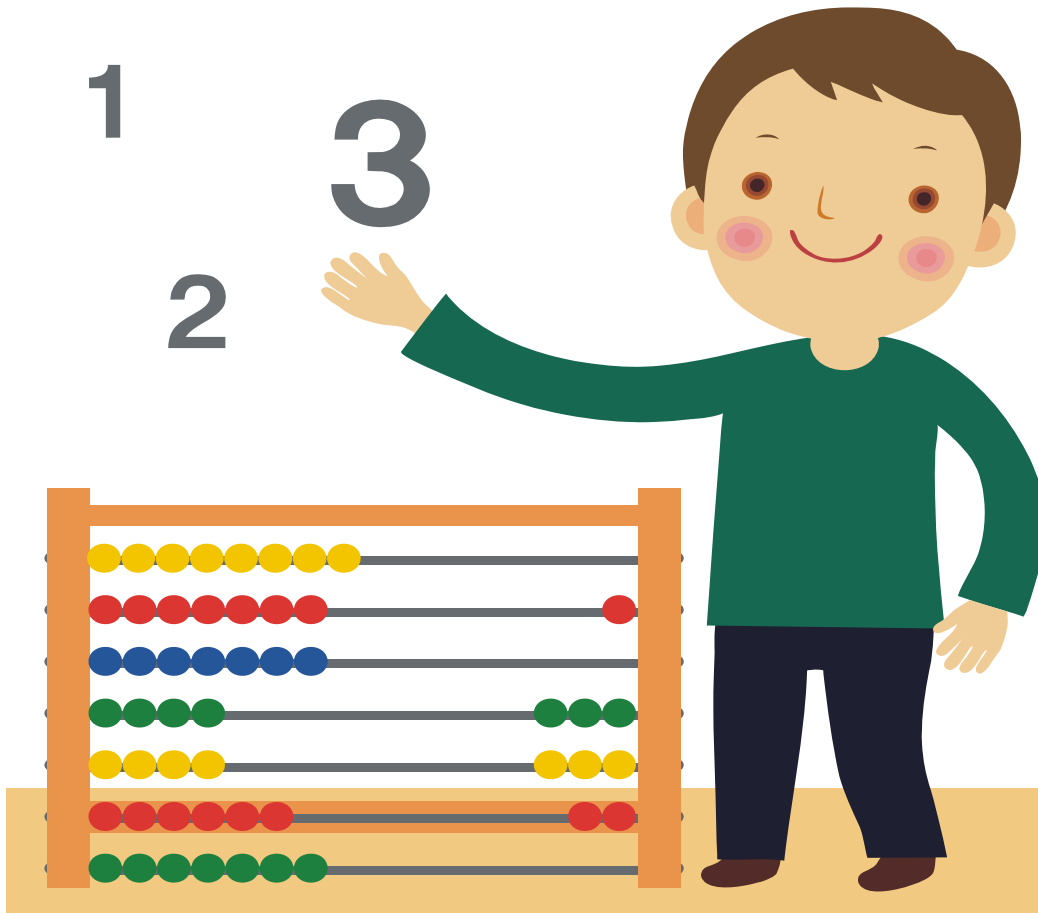

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How Do You Make An Itty Bitty Book?

- I do one for each number. They are a good self-esteem builder because the students are counting, writing and “reading” these Itty Bitty Books. Even tho’ it’s only an Itty Bitty Book, it’s still a book, and they are reading!!! ☺
- Put a cover on it. Each number has its own cover.
- Have them TRACE the letters/number on the cover and write their name on it.
- Include a 1-10 number page, and have them CIRCLE which number they are working on, include the number tracing page, and have them TRACE the number, then include a blank page and have them WRITE the number, then include the page with the group/set of that many things. Have them COLOR them in.
- That’s it. You’ve created a Numbit Itty Bitty Book.
- Now have your student read it to you.
- I have given you numbers 1 through 10 practice skill sheets to help students remember their numbers.
- I am a firm believer that if they spy it, see it, trace it, write it, read it, and associate it with a group of pictures as they count it, they will remember it.
- They can then take their little booklet home and share it with their family. This will again reinforce what they’ve learned as well as build their self-esteem.
- The other kind of Itty Bitty Book they can make with these number flashcards are skip counting booklets.
- They can skip count by 2’s, 5’s and 10’s.
- These booklets also have a cover page, and a complete counting template to insert after the cover page. Then add the set of numbers and have them trace them.
- This makes a great fine motor skill as they cut them out as well as nice sequencing practice.
- Our kindergartners have to count to 30 by 2’s, but I filled up the rest of the flashcards to 40. This way if you have students who are ahead of the game or need a challenge, you can “raise the bar” and have them make their books to 40.

What else can I do with the flashcards ?

- Run off the 4 different counting sets on different colored construction paper and laminate them. Use them as flashcards.
- You can also laminate sets in complimentary colors like hot pink and light pink and use them for a Concentration Match game, or for students to play Go Fish, or Old Maid card games.

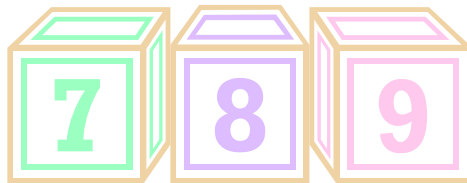
- Students can also lay them out on the table and practice sequencing them.
- Run off copies of the cards and use them as practice skill sheets for writing numbers.
- Use them for addition and subtraction equations, fact families etc. I've included a set of math signs if you want to do that.
- Because my students are Y5's and just learning how to IDENTIFY numbers, I scatter them on the floor and they gather them only if they can name the number.
- I put the cards in a box or bag (a plastic pumpkin during October) and I pass it around our circle when the children are sitting on the floor. Each child reaches in and picks out a card. They show it to their classmates and tell us what it is. I call this ***"Munch a bunch of numbers before lunch!"*** If they know the number they get a sticker. If not..."Better luck next time." And the audience helps them out, and the basket, box, bag is passed along 'til everyone has had a turn.
- If your students know their numbers they can pick two numbers out and add or subtract them. Or you can put a set of skip counting numbers in and the child has to skip count from the number they pick out of the basket. i.e., if they pick a 25 they start at 25, count by 5's to 50 or 100. This could be hard for a kindergartner, but not for a 1st grader.
- I paint the cards with glow-in-the-dark paint, turn off the lights and I let my students have a turn pointing to the cards with a laser.
- I'm sure you will think of other things to do with the cards. I'd enjoy hearing from you so we can add to the list and help other teachers! Thanks in advance.

Assessment Directions

- I've included assessments for you.
- I've left spaces next to the numbers so you can write down what number they say if they give you an incorrect answer.
- I check off a number if they get it correct.
- I make copies of these and send them home to parents. I circle the numbers their child needs help with.

Progress Certificate:

- I use this as a letter home to parents letting them know about the Itty Bitty books.
- I do most of them in class as a center activity, but occasionally you may want to send them home as a home-school connection. I know that some teachers are required to give homework and these are perfect for that.
